IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT

Our winter session will begin in just a few weeks! We have a great selection of classes to choose from that offers students some interesting and exciting after school learning opportunities. Enrollment is made on a first come, first serve basis & class sizes are limited, please be sure to return your enrollment forms by **Jan. 26th**.

Here are a few points to remember when enrolling your child in the after school program:

- **PERMISSION SLIP CHANGE**: You will now only have to fill out one permission slip which is attached on the registration form for your child to stay afterschool for the entire class session. Please remind your child each week that they should stay afterschool for their enrichment class. ****NOTE****: If your child **WILL NOT** be attending their ASE Program on any of the scheduled days, a note must be sent in to their teacher. If a note is not turned in, your child will remain at school until your arrive to pick them up.
- Classes will not run on early dismissal days or school closing due to inclement weather/holidays. We will notify you of all cancellations and possible make-up classes via phone or e-mail. Please be sure to mark the dates and times your child will be attending ASE on your calendars.
- Parents or guardians must sign out their children at the end of each class. A sign-out sheet will be available with the parent volunteer in each class location.
- Please be **ON TIME** for pick-up which is at **4:30pm**.
